**Interim Moderator** MOVED (Evans / McCullough) THAT the Reverend Keith McKee be discharged as Interim Moderator of New St. James Presbyterian Church, London, Ontario, with the thanks of the Court, effective the conclusion of the Induction of the Reverend Andrew Reid. CARRIED.

**Adjournment** MOVED (Evans / McKee) That the order of service for the Induction be the remainder of the docket and that the Court stand adjourned with the Benediction at the end of the service. CARRIED.

**Instructions from the Moderator** Following instructions from the Moderator and the Interim Moderator, the members of the Court and Session of New St. James Presbyterian processed into the service.

**Reception** A reception followed the Service of Induction, during which greetings were extended by members of the Presbytery of Hamilton, Clergy from other denominations in the locality, members and elders of New St. James Presbyterian Church.

**Next Meeting** The next regular meeting of the Presbytery of London will be held on Tuesday, the nineteenth day of June, two thousand and seven, at seven o'clock in the evening, in Komoka, and within Knox Presbyterian Church.
